Thank you for your delayed reply received on April 28th to my input on April 3rd. Unfortunately, the CDC's answer only covered one of my concerns. I believe this may be because the intake person I spoke to was unable to accept the detailed email I offered to send to her. As a result, she was clearly relying on notes she took and, further complicating the situation, when I first spoke to her she did not even know what a parking lot power sweeper was.

My other, more primary concern, is that currently open 'essential retail businesses' are not having their parking areas swept nightly. This is a serious concern given the volume of masks, gloves and other potentially infected items being left on lots. To make this concern more readily understandable, please go to the information page I have developed to outline this concern. That information is located here:

It seems clear that the CDC should be requiring essential retail business locations to be swept nightly during the duration of the pandemic lockdown.
